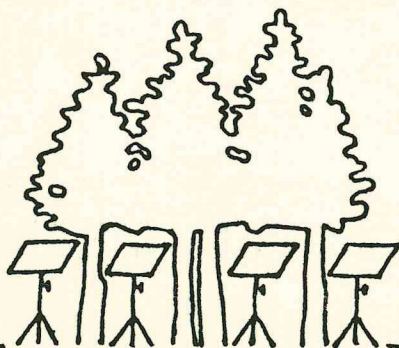

Stanza 1 - All Stanza 3 - Left (North) Side
Stanza 2 - Right (South) Side Stanza 4 - All

READING

from the Preface to Martin Luther's Summer Postil, 1544

HYMN

"O Lord, We Praise You" LBW 215
Stanzas 1 and 3 - All
Stanza 2:
Women: "Your...heaven"
Men: "No greater...us"
All complete the stanza in unison

READING

from Martin Luther's Sermon for the Third Sunday after Trinity, 1543

HYMN

"Lord, Keep Us Steadfast in Your Word" LBW 230
All stanzas are sung in unison. An organ improvisation precedes each stanza.

READING

from Martin Luther's Commentary on Galatians, 1535
and his Advent Postil, 1522

All stand for the Hymn and remain standing for the Prayer and Blessing.

HYMN

"A Mighty Fortress Is Our God" LBW 228 and 229
Stanza 1 - All (Setting: 228)
Stanza 2 - All in Harmony (Setting: 229)
Stanza 3 - Organ Improvisation
Stanza 4 - All in Unison (Setting: 229)

PRAYER All respond, Amen.

BLESSING All respond, Amen.

Then all are seated for the Postlude.
