





Since 1998, **Paul Morton** has served as Assistant Professor of Trumpet at the University of Louisiana at Lafayette. In addition to graduate and undergraduate trumpet, he also teaches jazz improvisation and high brass pedagogy. Dr. Morton performs and gives master classes across the United States and recently performed in St. Petersburg, Russia with the St. Petersburg Chamber Philharmonic. In April 2006, Dr. Morton toured Belgium as jazz soloist with the UL Lafayette Jazz Ensemble. Summer 2006 will mark Dr. Morton's tenth year with Lutheran Summer Music Academy and Festival.

Rick Orpen is Professor of Music at Gustavus Adolphus College in St. Peter, MN. He teaches courses in Music Theory, Composition, Jazz Improvisation, Percussion, and Guitar, and holds the Ph.D. degree from the University of Minnesota. His compositions for marimba are published by Keyboard Percussion Publications and he performs regularly with jazz artists Jim Whitman, James McGuire, and Charmin Michelle.

Karen Wilkerson is an active singer, educator, and conductor in the Twin Cities area. She has performed with the Minnesota Opera and the Dale Warland Singers. Ms. Wilkerson is director of adult choirs and handbells at Saint Michael's Lutheran Church, Roseville. She is on the voice faculty of Northwestern College, and in January of 2004 was a visiting professor at Gustavus Adolphus College. Wilkerson also is on the faculty at Luther Seminary. She holds degrees from California State University, Northridge, and Westminster Choir College.
