OUR PROGRAM

CORE COMPONENTS

Life at LSM is composed of three interconnected components — MUSIC, FAITH, and COMMUNITY.

MUSIC

Private Lessons. You receive two ½-hour lessons each week on your primary instrument or voice. You may register for lessons on a secondary instrument.

Large Ensemble. You are placed by audition in band, choir, or orchestra. To be considered for a second large ensemble on another instrument, you must submit an additional audition recording.

Small Ensemble. You will play or sing in a chamber ensemble coached by LSM faculty.

Musicianship Class. The LSM curriculum teaches music fundamentals and composition.

LSM Concert & Recital Series. More than 50 events feature world-class performances by the LSM faculty and inspiring offerings by our students (you!).

ELECTIVES

Customize your LSM experience! Our electives encourage musical exploration and help you build new skills.

YOU MAY CHOOSE ONE ELECTIVE FROM EACH OPTION BELOW.

ELECTIVE OPTION A

PERFORMANCE ELECTIVES, \$100 FEE

These include a featured performance during the final week.

Collegium Musicum. Learn about and perform on historical instruments (no audition required).

Advanced Handbells. For students with handbell experience (onsite audition required).

Jazz Ensemble. Explore this uniquely American music (onsite audition required).

Jazz Improvisation. Learn improvisation skills (no audition required).

INSTRUCTIONAL ELECTIVES, \$70 FEE (except for Church Music)

These classes build lifelong musical skills.

Class Piano. For beginners, learn the basics of piano in a small-group setting.

Class Piano. Identical to the class in Option A but offered on alternating days.

Beginning Handbells. Explore basic elements and techniques (no audition required).

Conducting. Explore styles and techniques. No experience necessary.

Church Music (NO FEE). Learn the roots of Lutheran hymnody and explore worship planning.

Intro to Pipe Organ. Learn how the pipe organ works and experience playing this majestic instrument.

Chapel Choir. Open to the entire LSM community, this non-audition choir rehearses daily and provides music for worship throughout LSM.

Introductory Voice Workshop. Students not enrolled in Choir may sign up for this introductory class to learn basic vocal methods and skills.

Need-based assistance.

Merit-based scholarships.

Awarded to students who show strong musical and technical proficiency as demonstrated by the submitted audition recording.

Match grants.

Donations from a business, organization, or church are eligible to be matched by LSM at 33%. Donations from a church may qualify you for additional discounts through our Young Musicians Partnership (see page 8).

Transportation grants.

Awarded to students who must travel a great distance to reach LSM.

FAQS

Is LSM only for Lutherans?

Absolutely not! While most of our students are Lutheran, we welcome and embrace students from many denominations and faiths.

What about the host campus?

Luther College is a private, liberal arts college renowned for its music program. The music building is home to a 325-seat recital hall, three rehearsal rooms, an organ studio, piano lab, percussion studio, faculty studios, and 36 practice rooms. The Center for Faith and Life is an acoustically designed concert and worship space for our large concerts. Dorm life in Farwell Hall and a gorgeous campus await you.

Is LSM accessible?

LSM provides reasonable accommodations for students with physical disabilities and engages a full-time nurse to support basic medical needs of students attending LSM. We do not discriminate on the basis of race, religion, creed, color, gender, disability, or national or ethnic origin.



How do I get there?

Decorah is located three hours southeast of the Minneapolis-St. Paul Int'l Airport (MSP). We provide a chaperoned shuttle between MSP and Decorah for a small fee.
