Who? Band, orchestra, choir, piano, pipe organ and (new for 2014!) composition students completing grades 8-12 from across the U.S. and abroad. Taught by 30+ world-class faculty artists and guided by a team of dedicated counselors.

What? A four-week residential training and performance program for students of all religious backgrounds. Musical study, rehearsal, and performance are rooted in an intentional community that supports musical *and* personal growth.

When? June 22 - July 20, 2014

Where? Luther College is located in beautiful Decorah, IA, three hours south of the Minneapolis-St. Paul International Airport.

OUR PROGRAM

LSM is comprised of three interconnected areas—MUSIC, FAITH, and COMMUNITY.

MUSIC

All LSM students participate in:

Private Lessons. You'll receive two ½-hour voice, instrument, or composition lessons each week. You may also register for lessons on a secondary instrument.

Large Ensemble. You'll be placed by audition in band, choir, or orchestra. Students interested in placement in a second large ensemble must also submit an audition recording for that instrument or voice.

Small Ensemble. You'll play or sing in a chamber ensemble or composition group coached by LSM faculty.

Musicianship Class. The LSM curriculum teaches music fundamentals and composition.

TUITION, ASSISTANCE, AND INCENTIVE

LSM IS AFFORDABLE

We're committed to accessibility and offer many forms of financial assistance. We will award more than \$145,000 in aid for LSM 2014:

- Need-based aid: based on each family's unique financial need.
- Merit-based scholarships: for students who show strong musical and technical proficiency.
- Young Musicians Partnership (and Match Grants): donations from churches, businesses, booster groups, and local organizations are eligible to be matched by LSM at 33%. Learn more (see page 8).
- Transportation grants: funds for students who must travel a great distance to get to LSM.

TUITION

With so many forms of support, LSM's base tuition of \$3,195 (includes four weeks room/board plus music instruction and activities) is significantly reduced for more than 80% of all applicants.

LSM: A GREAT INVESTMENT

Nearly half of all ELCA, LCMS, and independent Lutheran colleges in the U.S. offer scholarships *specifically* to recruit and retain LSM alumni. Scholarships range from \$500 to \$5,000 per year for undergraduate study at some of the country's top private liberal arts colleges. Decorah is located three hours southeast of the Minneapolis-St. Paul Int'l Airport (MSP). We provide a chaperoned shuttle between MSP and Decorah for a small fee.

Family and friends are invited (encouraged!) to join us for Festival Week. The final week of LSM features studio and chamber recitals, large ensemble concerts, a hymn festival, Bach Cantata, and more. Visit **www.lutheransummermusic.org** to begin your online application. You'll need to submit the following:

- A completed online application form
- A CD recording, live, Skype[®], YouTube[®], or electronically submitted audition (guidelines online)
- · A musical recommendation from a music teacher or director
- A personal recommendation from a teacher, pastor, or other adult
- A non-refundable \$25 application fee
